



Little Explorers Summer 2012

Little Explorers is designed to engage children in social interactions with their peers and increase group participation skills while working on receptive and expressive language. Children will participate in large motor group games, art, music, fine motor sensory and language comprehension activities. Little Explorers is for preschool children (3-5 years old) who are able to remain with a group, but lack the attention and participation needed to be in engaged. Children will need to bring a healthy snack, drink, and lunch with them.

Little Explorer Sample Daily Schedule

9:30-9:40	Independent table tasks Children will work on completing easy tasks independently at a group table.
9:40-9:45	Restroom Children will take a group restroom break working on waiting in the hall to take their turn and following a restroom procedure.
9:45-10:00	Recess Children will practice appropriate playground behavior and skills
10:00-10:30	Snack followed by Story with Follow-up Comprehension Activity Children will listen to a story read aloud to the group and will demonstrate comprehension of the story through either acting out parts of the story, answering group questions, and/or completing paper and pencil comprehension questions with picture choices.
10:30-10:45	Motor Activity and Turn Taking The focus will be on waiting and taking turns, as well as, listening to instructions provided to the group in order to complete a gross motor activity.
10:45-11:00	Art Activity Children will participate in a hands on art creation while interacting with their peers by requesting items from each other to complete the activity.
11:00-11:10	Restroom Children will take a group restroom break working on waiting in the hall to take their turn and following a restroom procedure.

| 11:10-11:40 | <p>Lunch
Focus will be on requesting from peers and teachers assistance, with their lunch, as well as passing out napkins and cups. <i>(Food will not be heated for lunch)</i></p> |
| 11:40-11:55 | <p>Group Game
Children will engage in group games that require group interactions and attention.</p> |
| 11:55-12:10 | <p>Recipe Activity
Children will follow simple recipes to create various mixtures for fine motor play. Focus will be on requesting needed materials and working with peers to create the mixtures.</p> |
| 12:10-12:30 | <p>Music
Children will participate in music activities through singing and gestural movements.</p> |
| 12:30-12:40 | <p>Restroom
Children will take a group restroom break working on waiting in the hall to take their turn and following a restroom procedure.</p> |
| 12:40-12:55 | <p>About My Day Activity
Each child will retell the activities from their day and fill out an About My Day sheet to assist them with retelling their day to their parents.</p> |
| 12:55-1:00 | <p>Get Ready to Leave
Children will gather their items and place them in their backpacks to go home.</p> |

Two certified Special Education and General Education teachers with numerous experiences in the public school system will teach the class. Both have extensive training and experience with Applied Behavior Analysis; one is currently a BCBA.

Goal Planning: The parents may provide the Executive Director with a CURRENT IEP for the classroom teacher to review for working on goals in the classroom setting.
