# The Learning Lane Community Outreach Program

## Parent / Caregiver Training Program

- The program consists of two (2 hour) training sessions for parents, siblings and caregivers.
- Parents will meet with a Learning Lane Team Member at your home or community outing.
- During these sessions, The Learning Lane Team Member will model effective strategies to help your child in their community plan.
- Each meeting the team member will work with your child and also watch the parent/caregiver participate within the activities that were modeled for your child in each training session.
- At the end of each monthly meeting the team member and parent/caregiver will meet for 30 minutes to discuss the goals and community plan in effect and make any adjustments that need to be made in order to effectively implement the community plan.

Monthly Hours – 4 hours of direct contact with child and 1 hour of session feedback (30 minutes each session) after each training session.

\*Cost - \$500.00 a month

Payment is due on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month. An invoice will be mailed out to the client on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month.

\* Standard mileage expense for anything over 25 miles from the central office location.

In order for the child to participate in the community outreach program a \*\* Learner Assessment will need to be completed by a Learning Lane Team Member for services to begin.

In order for the program to be effective we ask that all parents participate for at least 90 days/3 months to see the implementation results of the plan. A meeting will then take place at the end of the initial period to see if the client would like to continue or discontinue services.
